Fuel Up Equipment Grant 2025-2026

Overview of Fuel Up Equipment Grant Application 2025-2026

• One of two nutrition equipment kits—each valued at \$2,000—is available to qualified K-12 schools to improve access to nutritious foods.

Fuel Up Equipment Grant Options

 Your application must demonstrate how the funding will increase your students' access to and their consumption of dairy products (milk, yogurt, cheese). Your local Dairy Council can help you with ideas for how to increase dairy; find their contact information HERE.

Eligibility

- Open to K-12 schools that participate in the National School Lunch Program.
- Schools that have received funds or equipment in the past, or were declined in the past, can apply again.
- Schools that have received a Fuel Up grant in the past three years must have submitted all required final reporting.

Process

- Complete and submit the online application by Tuesday, April 8, 2025.
- Applications will be evaluated based on a variety of factors, including school enrollment, student reach, in-school support, school location, and the sustainability of the proposed program. Consideration will be given to schools in underserved communities whose students are most at risk for poor nutrition and childhood obesity.
- Applicants will receive decision notifications via email within eight weeks after the Application Deadline.
- Equipment will be shipped at back-to-school time (August/September 2025).

Reporting

If approved, your school will be expected to submit an online report at the end of the school year, including:

- The impact of your initiative on your students, staff, school, and community.
- Average Dairy Participation (ADP) for breakfast and lunch, as well as dairy sales data. Please work with your School Nutrition/Food Service Manager to supply this information.

Application Assistance

You are encouraged to contact your <u>local Dairy Council</u> with questions about the application process. They can be especially helpful in suggesting ways to increase dairy consumption at your school.



Grant Guidelines and Terms

- If the application is approved, your school must comply with all reporting requirements where
 you will be asked to document the use and impact of the grant (see Grant Reporting section
 below).
- Grant requests may only be submitted by schools, not individuals.
- There is one application deadline for the 2025-2026 school year: Tuesday, April 8, 2025.
- Limit one equipment package per school, valued at \$2,000.
- Fuel Up Equipment is meant to stimulate activities that lead to lasting change within the school environment.
- Schools are eligible to apply for Fuel Up Equipment if they have received other Fuel Up monies in previous years (from Dairy Council, NFL or other program supporters); however:
 - The current application must include a plan for activities that are different from or build upon past funded initiatives.
 - Schools that received Fuel Up grants in the past must have submitted all required reporting.
- Schools are eligible to apply even if they have received other funding to support health, physical activity and wellness at their school.
- Applicants will receive email notification of decisions within eight weeks after the Grant deadline. If awarded, your selected equipment will be received at back-to-school time (August/September 2025).

Grant Reporting

- Schools that receive equipment must complete an online report at the end of the 2025-2026 school year to document activities and impact. This report will require the following school meal information for the previous (2024-2025) and current (2025-2026) school years:
 - School Enrollment
 - Average Daily Participation (ADP) for Breakfast
 - Average Daily Participation (ADP) for Lunch
 - Total milk units distributed for the school year
 - Total single-serve yogurt units for the school year
 - Total bulk units of yogurt for the school year
- Failure to comply with the required reporting may prohibit the school from receiving future funding.

Grant Amounts and Limits

Each school will be awarded a single equipment kit, valued at \$2,000. Equipment should be incorporated into the school's food service program by the end of the 2025-2026 school year.

Use of Equipment

- Equipment should be used to increase access to and consumption of healthy foods, including dairy, for all students.
- The equipment selected as part of this application cannot be changed once the application is submitted.
- Grant recipient agrees to use the equipment as outlined in the approved application.
- Recipient will not use Fuel Up equipment to:
 - o Influence legislation
 - Influence the outcome of any public election or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive
 - o Make any grant to any other individual or organization
 - o Undertake any activity other than for charitable, scientific or educational purposes

Other Terms

- Equipment is the property of the school that is approved and may not be transferred to another school, institution or individual without prior written approval of the Fuel Up funder.
- Schools receiving equipment agree to provide information about use of the equipment if requested by National Dairy Council, local Dairy Council or GENYOUth.
- All information provided in connection with the Fuel Up Equipment Grant Application, including all related communications, is true, correct and complete.
- Equipment recipient will maintain complete and accurate records for the program and will make such records available to Dairy Council and GENYOUth Foundation upon request.
- Equipment recipient agrees to share success, if requested, to demonstrate progress made toward creating a healthy and active school community.
